Class Dojo




We kindly ask that all parents are signed up to and regularly check Class Dojo, as this is our main method of communication with families. Important updates, reminders, and messages from staff are shared here, so we encourage you to check it daily to stay informed.

Is your child prepared for school?

Please ensure your child is fully prepared and equipped for a successful return to school. Please take a moment to check that they have the correct uniform and equipment:

School Uniform

- Grey trousers, skirt, or pinafore
- White or red polo shirt
- Red sweatshirt or cardigan – preferably with the school logo (plain red is also acceptable)
- Plain white, black, or grey ankle socks or tights
- Black school shoes
- Red book bag – preferably with the school logo (plain red is also acceptable)



Sports Kit

- Red t-shirt – preferably with the school logo (plain red or white is also acceptable)
- Black shorts or jogging bottoms
- Trainers
- Red drawstring bag – preferably with the school logo (plain red is also acceptable)

Please note: Sports kits should be kept in school until half-term, when they will be sent home for washing.

Other Essentials

A named water bottle should be brought in daily.


Punctuality Reminder

Letters will be going out this week regarding our annual camping event, which will take place on **Friday 26th September**. This event is open to all pupils in Year 5 and Year 6.

Now in its eighth year, our on-site camp has become a much-loved tradition and is always a highlight of the school calendar. Please note that places are limited.

If your child would like the opportunity to attend, they will need to complete an application form, explaining why they would like to be chosen. This is a great chance for pupils to express their enthusiasm and show us why they'd make a great camper!

Completed forms must be returned to school no later than 9:00am on Thursday 11th September. Children will be informed on Friday 12th September if they have been successful. At that time, a letter will be sent home with further details and a request for full payment of £32.
